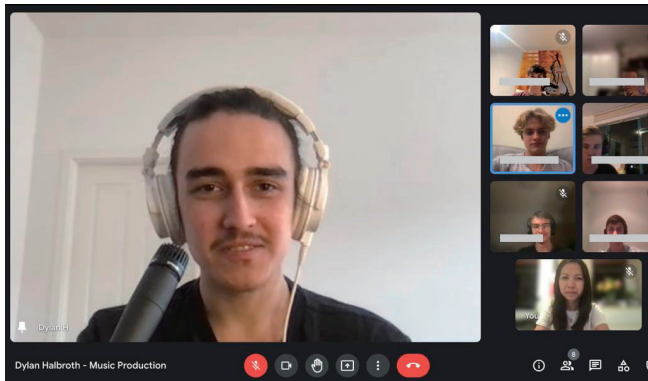


Finding Career Inspiration With Hong Kong Academy

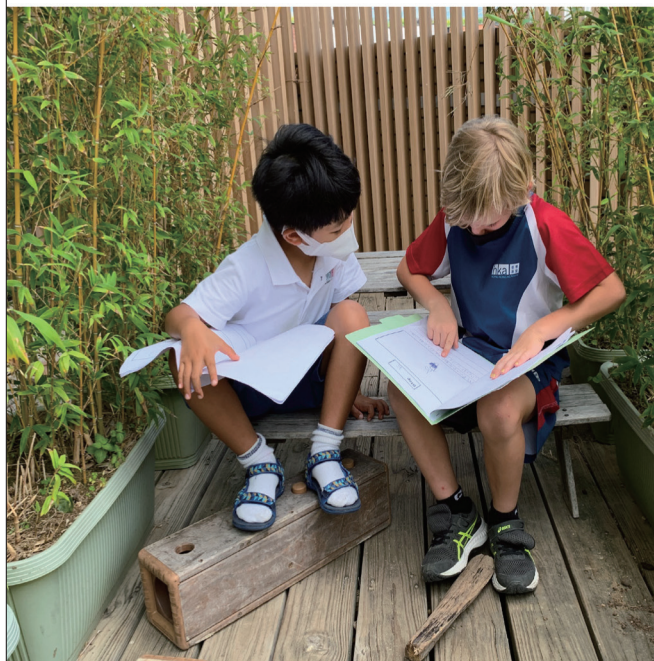
